

WAGES AND HOW YOU'LL BE PAID

- You will be paid in Australian Dollars (AUD)
- You will require an Australian Tax File Number. This needs to be arranged once you arrive. You will be taxed on your earnings which is deducted from your weekly pay.
- You will require an Australian Bank Account to deposit your wages. You can do this yourself or we can do it for you. Should we do it for you, you will be issued with a "Bendigo Bank" account. This will also be arranged after your arrival. Please note it will be your responsibility to close this account on your departure from Australia to ensure no ongoing fees and charges.
- For your initial 8-week program you will be set up as a "casual worker". You are <u>NOT</u> entitled to Holiday pay, Sick leave or Long Service Leave accrual. Should you choose to extend your stay with Plumbrite Group International, your ongoing wages and entitlements will be discussed with you.
- The working week is generally Monday to Friday (7:00am 3:30pm).
- You will be entitled to a paid rostered day off (RDO) every 4th Friday or Monday.
 (40 hour working week, paid 38 hrs p/w accrues x1 paid RDO per month)
- You will be offered an hourly rate between \$30-50 AUD dependant on each individual's skill level and experience. Your hourly rate will be determined and noted within your formal offer, following your successful application.
- The pay week runs from Thursday Wednesday.
- Your first pay will be on the 2nd Wednesday after your arrival.
- Overtime opportunities available.

AFTER THE INITIAL PROGRAM IS COMPLETE...

- You may be offered a more permanent position through Company sponsorship.
- You may purchase various packages to extend your stay with Plumbrite Group International. This may be in your current location of Melbourne, or you may request relocation to a different state. This will be subject to employment availability. Extension packages start from \$3500.00 USD per month.
- Successful applicants can generally stay in Australia for up to 12 months on their working/travel visa. Should you choose to cease your commitment to the Plumbrite Group International banner after your 8 weeks, you may:
 - A) Head home B) Find your own employment C). Travel

Should you choose A, B or C you will remain entitled to your return flight home. (MEL to L.A). You are responsible to ensure this is organised a minimum of 6 weeks before departure if maximizing the full term of your visa.

Plumbrite Group International would like to encourage all candidates to explore Australia during their stay, whether that be just your local area, the state of Victoria or beyond...

<u>Please note: Initial 8-week program is located in Melbourne only.</u>

SERIOUS INJURY OR ILLNESS

In the unfortunate event you experience serious illness or injury which results in an inability to work and/or hospitalisation for a period of 1 week or more. Your options for an early release of your contract can be discussed. Should you choose to head home, you will incur no additional costs, and your return flight (MEL-L.A) will be provided. You will however not be eligible for any refunds.

Any injuries that occur during work hours will be covered via our workcover insurance.

DRIVING IN AUSTRALIA

- Australian's drive on the left-hand side of the road from the right-hand side of the vehicle. This can take some time to adjust. Give yourself extra room, extra time and we ask that you always remain focused and alert.
- It is your responsibility to research and be aware of the road rules.
- In the event of an accident which deems you at fault, you will be required to pay the vehicle insurance excess of \$1000.00 AUD for the vehicle to be repaired.
- It is illegal to drive under the influence of all illicit and recreational drugs. The legal driving limit for alcohol is under 0.05 (Roadside breath tests are common, so don't risk it. It will result in large fines and/or loss of license.) Plumbrite Group expects its employees to practice 0.00 during work hours and/or whilst wearing Company uniform.
- Driving and texting is illegal. There are now cameras located on some traffic lights which if caught with a mobile device in your hand you will be sent a very hefty fine in the mail (upwards of \$500 AUD and the loss of demerit points. You have 12 demerit points. Once you have no demerit points left, it can result in a suspension of your ability to drive in Australia.
- Victoria Police love speeding fines. Via radar, unmarked cars and roadside cameras. It's not worth it. They will get you! Fines are expensive and will result in the loss of demerit points.


The township of Kangaroo Ground holds true to its name... There is an abundance of kangaroos in the area. They are not the smartest of animals and are known to frequently jump in front or alongside your vehicle. Deer are also known throughout the area. We encourage you to drive slowly and cautiously on our local roads. They can cause a lot of damage to you and your vehicles.

Kangaroos are not as friendly as they look – they can be aggressive, and it is recommended you do not provoke or try to approach.




CONDITIONS

PRE-DEPARTURE CHECK LIST

Passport and Visa documents.
Driver's license.
Travel Insurance. You will be covered during work hours whilst working under the Plumbite Group banner but not outside of your working hours
Access to money for social, tourist experiences and personal expenses.
Access to money for food expenses.
Your Plumbrite welcome uniform. Please wear this on departure day.
Work shorts/pants. (Navy Blue)
Steel capped boots. **This is an Australian health and safety workplace requirement.



YOUR STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

Submit your Plumbrite Group international – Trade's Abroad application form online at https://plumbrite.com.au/about/
 (Plumbrite will contact you to arrange a virtual interview to assess experience, communication skills, and suitability.

2. Receive Conditional Approval:

Successful candidates will receive an acceptance letter within 1 week of your virtual interview.

3. Secure The Package

- Submit electronically signed information booklet at <u>https://plumbrite.com.au/about/</u>
- Payment of \$1000.00 (USD) Deposit. This is non-refundable. Pay in full and receive 5% discount off total price. (Saving you \$447.50 USD). For any reason should your Visa not be approved, you will receive a full refund minus the \$1000.00 deposit.
- Start your Visa application Do this as soon as possible.
- Submit additional information as outlined in your letter of congratulations.
- You will receive your Plumbrite Group International welcome pack within a few weeks.

Candidates must commit to the following terms of payment if not paying in full.

- Pay 50% of the package fee a minimum of 1 month prior to departure.
- Full payment required minimum of 2 weeks prior to departure. (Preferred payment; Zelle.)
- 4. After 50% payment is received... (1 month prior to departure) Flight and Accommodation Arrangements:
 - Pending Visa approval confirmation Plumbrite admin will book your flights on Qantas Australia and notify you of your flight information

5. Pre-Departure Checklist

- Check it and make sure you have everything ready to go for departure day.
- Travel Insurance documents.
- 6. Finalize Payment -This payment is required minimum 2 weeks prior to departure.
- You will be sent your flight itinerary, including airport transfer information and room allocation.



7. Prepare for Departure:

- Confirm you have everything from Pre-departure check list.
- Connect with a dedicated Plumbrite advisor for any final queries.

8. Arrival and Orientation

- a. <u>Airport Pickup:</u>
- You will be transferred to your accommodation as per your itinerary details.

We will endeavour for your arrival to Melbourne to be on a Thursday. This will give you the opportunity to arrange your tax file number and bank account on Friday and settle into your surroundings over the weekend before starting work on Monday.

There will be work vehicles available at the house to go to grocery store, bank, work etc

- b. <u>7:00am Monday Morning Orientation Session:</u>
- Meet members of the Plumbrite Team.
- Overview of work expectations, safety protocols etc.
- Pick up tools (your basic tools for your use through the program.)
- Receive your local SIM card.

9. Start your work placement

- Generally, work will start 7:00am.
- 320 hours minimum over 8 weeks. RDO's included.

Ongoing Support:

• Plumbrite will offer ongoing support during your placement, including problem resolution and guidance. We want everyone to feel comfortable and safe so you can maximize your adventure. You are encouraged to discuss any issues or concerns that arise privately with a member of the Plumbrite Team.

10. Post-Placement Options

Stay and Work with us for Longer:

 Apply for mutual recognition of U.S. credentials in Australia to continue your growth and development.



• Purchase additional packages for new placements. Other states are an option depending on availability and your trade of interest.

Explore Australia:

• Use the flexibility of your return ticket and maximize your visa to travel. Freelance or just holiday.

Return to the U.S.

• Fly home after your 60-day package is complete.

You must remain employed with Plumbrite Group International for the duration of your initial package to remain eligible for the return ticket home.

Should your contract be terminated for any reason or you choose to depart early, the return ticket home will be at your own cost.
